

RESOLUTION NO. 010-2013

OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, California Vehicle Code Section 9250.19 was enacted by the legislature in 1997 and empowered your Board to direct the California Department of Motor Vehicles to collect a \$1 fee per vehicle that can be expended exclusively to fund programs that enhance the capacity of local law enforcement to provide automated mobile and fixed location fingerprint indentification of individuals who may be involved in driving under the influence of alcohol or drugs or vehicular manslaughter or any combination of those and other vehicle-related crimes, and other crimes committed while operating a motor vehicle.

WHEREAS, on December 9, 1997, Resolution 270-97 was adopted by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to California Vehicle Code Section 9250.19, imposing the collection of an additional \$1 fee on motor vehicles registration fee.

WHEREAS, the Sheriff, County Cal-Identification Remote Access Network Board, and the Auditor-Controller agree the collection of \$1 vehicle registration fee to County of El Dorado residents levied by the Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) pursuant to Vehicle Code 9250.19 for automated fingerprint identification services is no longer necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Supervisors suspend the collection of this \$1 vehicle registration fee for automated fingerprint services by rescinding Resolution 270-97.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Supervisors give authority to Sheriff and Auditor-Controller to execute any further documents required by DMV to cease the collection of this \$1 fee.
