This modification No. 006 is "adding" funding to our already existing U. S. Forest Service Contract #08-LE-11051360-002 that was approved by the Board of Supervisors on 12-15-2009 #13. 08-1071.

On that date, a \$36,000 contract was approved.

Exhibit A (FY09/10) was for \$31,000 (\$26,000 National Forest & \$5,000 Lake Tahoe Basin Mgt)

Exhibit B (FY09/10) was for \$5,000

The Forest Service has amended Exhibit B to include the following:
