

## RESOLUTION NO. 125-2016

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

## Resolution for Additional Road Closure for the "Wilson Estates Sewer Line"

WHEREAS, Renasci Homes (Sponsor) has previously requested a road closure "Special Event Permit" pursuant to Vehicle Code 21101(e), Ordinance Code § 12.37.010 et seq., and County Resolution No. 110-79 in order to construct the "Wilson Estates Sewer Line" beginning Wednesday, June 29, 2016, for thirty (30) calendar days; and

WHEREAS, On June 28, 2016 the Board approved Resolution No. 101-2016 authorizing the closure of portions of Uplands Drive and Malcolm Dixon Road, on a daily basis between 8:00 a.m. and 5:00 p.m. for a period of up to thirty (30) days to allow for construction of a sewer line necessary for the Wilson Estates project; and

WHEREAS, said Sponsor now desires an additional road closure of Malcolm Dixon Road for the construction of a particularly deep section of sewer line which requires special excavation and trench shoring methods; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that an additional road closure will be in effect for Malcolm Dixon Road in the El Dorado Hills area from 100 feet east of Alta Vista Court to 50 feet west of the driveway to 1401 Malcolm Dixon Road from 7:00 a.m. Monday, July 25, 2016 to 7:00 p.m. Friday, July 29, 2016, including work hours from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. during construction of a sewer line to serve the Wilson Estates Subdivision development (TM14-1515). The closure is subject to conditions set forth in Resolution No. 110-79 dated May 1, 1979.

This Resolution, in conjuction with Resolution No. 101-2016 and the "Special Event Permit Application" with fulfilled conditions shall together constitute the road closure "Special Event Permit."

## REQUEST FOR MALCOLM DIXON ROAD CLOSURE

We request authorization from the El Dorado County Transportation Department to close Malcolm Dixon Road from 0700 hours, Monday, 25 July 2016 until 1900 hours, Friday, 29 July 2016 in order to install the improvements detailed on the Wilson Estates improvement plans. The closure would be from 100 feet east of Aqua Vista Ct. to 50 feet west of the driveway to 1401 Malcolm Dixon Road. The closure would not block access to any property on Malcolm Dixon Road. We will work from 0700 to 1900 each day, in order to finish the work as quickly as possible. As soon as the construction is complete we will open the road.
