NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED AND ORDERED, allocation changes resulting from the budget process for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 are hereby adopted, and amendments to Authorized Personnel Allocation Resolution #102-2015 are hereby incorporated, and the number and classification of all authorized positions in each County department is set forth as follows, effective upon adoption of the Board of Supervisors.
