Recommendations:

The Department of Transportation (Department) recommends the Board of Supervisors (Board) take the following actions regarding the Cameron Park Drive and Coach Lane Intersection Improvements Project #73321:

1. Approve the Plans and Contract Documents and authorize the Board Chairman to sign the plans, and
2. Authorize advertisement for construction bids.

Reasons for Recommendations:

In response to a demonstrated need, the Department included an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) project in our capital improvement program. The original project description included modified pedestrian ramps and signal actuators on all four corners. The project is located south of Highway 50 at the intersection of Cameron Park Drive and Coach Lane. This area is commercial with heavy pedestrian traffic.

During the same time period as the Department was advancing the ADA project, the Planning Commission approved Special Use Permit (SUP) # S70-0025R for the Chevron gas station remodel on the northwest corner parcel. Condition # 16 of the SUP approval required that the curb radius at the northwest corner (location of Chevron gas station) be increased to 40-foot radius and that the SUP applicant prepare the required bid-ready off-site plans to be bid for construction by the County. Because of the

extensive curb change, the proposed modification also required changes to the existing signal configuration: poles, cabinet, power supply, etc.

Due to the close proximity of the proposed improvements, the two project elements: ADA compliance project and the Chevron gas station remodel off-site requirements were incorporated into one project bid package by County staff as presented in this agenda item for your Board approval.

The Department has already received the CEQA Notice of Exemption and accepted an Irrevocable Offer of Dedication from the Chevron property owner for that corner. No other property rights need to be acquired for the project.

Fiscal Impact:

The cost associated for the construction phase of this project is estimated at \$378,000, which includes an estimated bid of \$282,000, supplemental items at \$20,000, construction management, surveying services, and materials testing at \$48,000, and a contingency of \$28,000.

This project is funded through 2004 General Plan Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee Program. Sufficient funds are available in the Program to fund the project. The project is included in the 06/07 CIP budget.


Net County Cost:

2. The Department will advertise for construction bids and at the completion of the bidding period return to the Board for consideration to award the construction contract, pursuant to the Department's recommendation.
