### **Recommendations:**

The Department of Transportation (DOT) recommends that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. Authorize the Chair to sign a Claim to the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) for Transportation Development Act (TDA), Local Transportation Funds (LTF) in the amount of \$59,762.
- 2. Authorize the Chair to sign a Claim to the TRPA for TDA, State Transit Assistance Funds (STA) in the amount of \$263,626.
- 3. Authorize the Chair to sign the Resolution authorizing DOT to file Claims for 2006/2007 LTF and STA funds for operation of the South Lake Tahoe Transit Program.

### Reasons for Recommendation:

Annually the TRPA allocates TDA funds to El Dorado County. The TDA consists of two sources of funds: the Local Transportation Fund, Article 4, (LTF) and the State Transit Assistance (STA) funds. The purpose of these funds is to provide public transportation within the unincorporated area of the Tahoe Basin. The total 2006/2007 allocation is \$607,753, \$344,127 from LTF and \$263,626 from STA.

The existing transit services require \$323,388 of the current year's \$607,753 allocation leaving an unappropriated balance of \$284,365. In FY 2003/2004 and 2005/2006 the TDA funds available to El Dorado County exceeded the amount of the TDA claims submitted to TRPA for those years due to revised allocations and an increase in estimated carryover funds made available. On June 30, 2007 a total of \$348,909 is expected to be in the County's TDA account available for future allocation as needed. TRPA will be conducting an Unmet Transit Needs hearing in the near future and the Department will explore alternative uses for this funding. Future claims for this funding will be brought before your Board.

Section 6630 of the TDA regulations requires that an annual claim be filed with the local transportation planning agency to receive funds from the Local Transportation Fund and Section 6732 of the TDA regulations requires that an annual claim be filed to receive funds from the State Transit Assistance Fund. The TRPA requires a resolution by your Board approving the claims and authorizing their submittal by DOT. DOT proposes to use these funds to operate the South Lake Tahoe Transit program, which provides public transit services in the unincorporated area of the Tahoe Basin for seniors, the disabled, and the general public.

### Fiscal Impact:

The allocated TDA funds in addition to passenger fares estimated at \$60,000 and a Federal Transit Assistance grant for \$20,000 will provide the total funding required to operate the existing South Lake Tahoe Transit program. TDA funds in the amount of \$323,388 have been included in the FY 2006/2007 budget.

Attachment "A", Proposed Activities and Allocations for South Lake Tahoe Transit, depicts the activities to be provided and the recommended funding allocation.

### Action to be Taken Following Approval:

Upon approval of the recommendations, DOT will submit the signed claims for LTF and STA funds to the TRPA for approval by their Board.

SUBJECT: FY 2006-2007 LTF and STA ESTIMATES

The purpose of this letter is to notify El Dorado County of the estimate funds available through the Transportation Development Act (TDA) for FY 2006-2007 within the Tahoe Region. The TDA consists of two sources of funds for local counties: the Local Transportation Fund (LTF) and the State Transit Assistance (STA) funds.

TRPA has been notified by the El Dorado County Auditor Controller of the estimated LTF available for FY 2006-2007. The attached page shows the breakdown of LTF allocations between El Dorado County and the City of South Lake Tahoe. The total LTF Allocation for El Dorado County, within the Tahoe Region, for FY 2006-2007 is \$344,127.00. TRPA does not anticipate any major changes to the allocation. However, if the Auditor-Controller's office notifies TRPA of any revisions, TRPA will notify El Dorado County DOT as soon as possible.

TRPA has also been notified by the State Controller's Office of the estimated State Transit Assistance (STA) available in the Tahoe Region for FY 2006-2007. According to this initial estimate, El Dorado County would be eligible to receive \$ 96,373 in STA. The SCO will submit a revised STA estimate in August 2006.

Please note that each of the operators is due for a performance audit during FY 2006-2007. TRPA will hire the consultant and seek reimbursement from each of the operators subsequent to the completion of the audits. The cost per operator will most likely be in the \$5,000 to \$8,000 range. Please be prepared to reimburse TRPA for this cost upon the completion of the audits.

Please complete the attached claim forms and submit it to TRPA. The Transportation Development Act (TDA) requires that each claim be accompanied by the statements as outlined in Section 6632 of the TDA Rules and Regulations.

SUBJECT: FY 2006-2007 REVISED STA ESTIMATE

In February of this year the Tahoe Regional Planning Agency (TRPA) submitted to El Dorado County an estimate of Local Transportation Funds (LTF) and State Transit Assistance (STA) funds available for the 2006-2007 fiscal year. TRPA recently received a revised estimate of STA from the State Controller's Office. The initial LTF estimate for the year remains valid.

The STA estimates for the Lake Tahoe Region have increased substantially. I have contacted the State Controller's Office regarding the reason for the increase. The increase is the result of funds that were available for budgeting in several previous years but were not actually programmed. This will make up for several recent years at one time.

The STA allocation that will be available to El Dorado County for the 2006-2007 fiscal year is \$263,626 (an increase of \$167,253 from the \$96,373 preliminary estimate).

As stated above, this increase has resulted from specific events that made this level of funding available for this particular year. Although it is likely that subsequent year's allocations may be slightly higher than recent years, they will not be as high as this allocation. Please keep this in mind when programming these funds.

As TRPA informed with the preliminary estimate, each of the operators is due for a performance audit during FY 2006-2007. We will keep you apprised of the status of the audits and let you know when reimbursement will be due.

Please complete the claim forms submitted with the preliminary estimate and submit them to TRPA. The Transportation Development Act (TDA) requires that each claim be accompanied by the statements as outlined in Section 6632 of the TDA Rules and Regulations.
