□ RECOMMENDATION:

The El Dorado County Air Quality Management District (AQMD) is recommending the Board approve the proposed disbursal of the DMV surcharge fees for funding of six (6) vehicle emissions reduction projects, for which applications were submitted per FY2006-07 Request for Proposals.

□ BACKGROUND:

On July 14, 2006 the AQMD initiated Request for Proposal (RFP) to seek applications for eligible motor vehicle emission reduction projects or programs to be funded from DMV Surcharge Fees collected for the AQMD under the AB2766. The application period ended on August 18, 2006, and the AQMD received applications for six eligible projects. The total amount of requested funding for the six projects is \$219,788. The AQMD has \$205,000 available for FY2006-07 DMV grants.

□ REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATION:

The following table summarizes the submitted projects; funding requests, emission reductions and annualized cost effectiveness, as well as the AQMD proposal evaluation ranking and the recommended funding for each project. The AQMD recommends reduced funding by \$5,000 (12%) for the Apple Hill Shuttle. The AQMD also recommends reduced funding by \$9,751 (15%) for the Fire Safe Council. All other projects are proposed to receive full funding.
