

**Recommendation:**

I recommend that the Board adopt the attached resolution amending compensation for precinct workers.

**Reason for Recommendation:**

The impact of the new electronic voting equipment in El Dorado County introduced in the June 6, 2006 Primary election has taught us that in order to become self sustaining we must provide additional training for a person within each polling place, that of a Poll Worker Technician who will be trained in the setting up and trouble shooting of the new electronic voting equipment.

This is intended to be a one time training opportunity on a larger than usual basis. We will be able to use remaining HAVA 301 training funds for this year, so this activity will not impact the general fund.

The attached resolution will maintain the current per diem compensation rates for precinct workers but allow for a one-time stipend to be paid to precinct workers who have completed the training and become certified as Poll Worker Technicians.

**Fiscal Impact:**

I intend to use HAVA 301 funding which is still available for training. Therefore, there should be no fiscal impact on the county general fund.

**Action to be taken Following Approval:**

Upon adoption of the resolution, I will set up the training schedules for this additional training and immediately commence start up of the training module.

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 12310 of the Elections Code of the State of California, The Board of Supervisors adopted Resolution #269-99 establishing compensation for precinct workers at the per diem rates specified below; and

Inspectors	\$120
Judges	\$105
Clerks	\$95

**WHEREAS**, the implementation of new electronic voting equipment has created a need for additional training for precinct workers; and

**WHEREAS**, the registrar of Voters desires to compensate precinct workers who become certified as Poll Worker Technicians through successful completion of the necessary training.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that precinct workers who are certified as Poll Worker Technicians and who work on the General Election to be held on November 7, 2006 receive a one-time stipend of \$20.00. The stipend shall be in addition to the normal rates of compensation as set forth above.
