Recommendations:

The Department of Transportation recommends that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1. conduct a public hearing to accept testimony of all interested persons for or against the formation of the Hawk View Zone of Benefit #98613;
- 2. make findings consistent with the County's *Policy and Procedure Guidelines for Creation and Administration of Zones of Benefit Within a County Service Area,Part III, C* included in the attached Resolution and detailed in this Board Letter; and
- 3. if there is no majority protest, adopt and authorize the Chair to sign the attached Resolution forming the Hawk View Zone of Benefit #98613.

Reasons for Recommendations:

An application has been submitted and reviewed by staff to form the Hawk View Zone of Benefit #98613. The proposed zone consists of approximately 40.1 acres located south of Green Valley Road and west of Bass Lake Road, north of US Highway 50 in the El Dorado Hills area, consisting of one parcel owned by a single landowner. There are no registered voters residing within the boundaries of the proposed zone.

As required by the County's *Policy and Procedure Guidelines for Creation and Administration of Zones of Benefit Within a County Service Area* ("Guidelines"), as amended and adopted by your Board on June 2, 1987, this public hearing has been scheduled and noticed pursuant to Government Code §6061 to accept public comment regarding the formation of the zone of benefit.

The Guidelines require that the following findings be made at the hearing:

- that the road and drainage facility improvement and maintenance services, as described in the application, are extended County services as defined in the County Service Area Law (Government Code §25210.1 et seq.);
- that the services to be provided within the zone are road and drainage facility improvement and maintenance services;
- that the extent of any protest against establishing the zone or the furnishing of a specified type or types of extended services within the zone has been noted;
- that the boundaries of the proposed zone have been determined and shall be as described in Exhibits A and B hereto;
- that the estimated annual cost of the services within the zone for the first year will be \$381.00 per parcel;
- that the establishment of the zone shall be accomplished without a confirmation election:
- that the proposed boundaries of the zone include no land devoted primarily to agricultural or livestock uses and being used for the commercial production of agricultural or livestock products;
- that an Advisory Committee will not be appointed for the zone; and
- that a special tax to be levied within the proposed zone and an election to authorize
 the levy of the special tax will be considered under a companion agenda item and
 separate associated Resolution.

A copy of the application is on file with the Board Clerk. The zone *Guidelines* require dedication of the road and drainage easements with the formation application. However, because dedication of the easements is also required as a condition of approval of the final subdivision map (Items 16 and 34 of the Conditions of Approval for TM 00-1371), the requirement is deemed satisfied for the purposes of zone formation. This is consistent with prior practice.

Fiscal Impact:

The minimal costs associated with the formation of the zone will be paid by the applicant, and funding for extended services will be through a special tax if approved by a mailed ballot landowner election.

- 1. The Board of Supervisors will approve and the Chair will sign the Resolution forming the Hawk View Zone of Benefit #98613.
- 2. The Clerk of the Board will have the Resolution recorded upon signature by the Chair, and will provide two certified copies of the Resolution to the El Dorado County Department of Transportation and one copy of the Resolution to the Planning Department.
- 3. The Department of Transportation will file the Resolution approving the formation, the legal description and map with the State Board of Equalization.
- 4. A Resolution calling for a mailed ballot landowner election to establish a special tax will be considered by your Board under a companion agenda item.

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado has formed County Service Area #9 pursuant to Title 3, Division 2, Part 2, Chapter 2.2 of the California Government Code; and

WHEREAS, this Board may establish zones of benefit within any county service area to provide extended services including but not limited to road and drainage facility improvement and maintenance services; and

WHEREAS, this Board adopted the County of El Dorado Policy and Procedure Guidelines for Creation and Administration of Zones of Benefit Within a County Service Area as amended June 2, 1987; and

WHEREAS, a complete application was submitted requesting the formation of a zone of benefit to provide road and drainage facility improvement and maintenance services within the boundaries of County Service Area #9 consistent with the guidelines; and

WHEREAS, a Petition to Form a Zone of Benefit was signed by the requisite number of property owners within the proposed zone of benefit; and

WHEREAS, County staff has validated the information contained in the application; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on October 3, 2006 at 9:00 a.m. and was noticed pursuant to \$6061 of the Government Code; and

WHEREAS, on October 3, 2006 the Board determined that no majority protest was registered against the formation of the zone as described in Exhibit A and shown on Exhibit B;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED the Board of Supervisors determines as follows:

1. The formation of Hawk View Zone of Benefit #98613 within County Service Area #9 is hereby made; and

All that real property situate in the County of El Dorado, State of California, being a portion of the Southwest one-quarter of Section 31, T.10 N., R.9 E., M.D.M. and being a portion of Parcel 'A' as shown on that certain Parcel Map filed in the office of the County Recorder in Book 18 of Parcel Maps, page 80, and being more particularly described as follows:

Beginning at a 1/12" capped iron pipe stamped LS 3864 marking the Southwest corner of said Parcel 'A' & from which NGS Station, HPGN D CA 03 DL bears South 51°33'46" West, 7,873.09 feet; thence along the following 12 courses:

- 1) Along the West line of said Parcel 'A', North 00°24'14" West, 1316.31 feet cited as North 00°25'11" West, 1316.07 feet; to the Northwest corner of said parcel 'A'; thence

- 7) South 10°20'58" East, 215.95 feet cited as South 10°20'16" East; thence
- 8) Along the arc of a curve to the right, having a radius of 1350,00 feet and being subtended by a chord bearing South 06°25'03" East, 185,14 feet cited as South 06°24'21" East; thence
- 9) Along the arc of a curve to the right, having a radius of 20.00 feet and being subtended by a chord bearing South 43°24'39" West, 28.72 feet cited as South 43°25'03" West; thence
- 10) South 89°18'27" West, 129,38 feet cited as South 89°18'33" West, 129.39 feet; thence
- 11) South 00°41'33" East, 30.00 feet cited as South 00°41'27" East, to a point on the South line of said Parcel 'A': thence
- 12) Along the South line of said Parcel 'A', South 89°18'27" West, 1170.95 feet, to the Point of Beginning containing an area of 38.47 acres more or less.


