Recommendation:

The Department of Transportation recommends that the Board approve the revision to Resolution No. 247-81, which establishes speed restrictions pursuant to Section 10.08.020, of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code, as approved by the Traffic Advisory Committee in the West Slope. Back-up documentation is on file with the Clerk of the Board.

Specific Sites:

1. Increase of speed limit on Knollwood Drive (No. 21) from the existing twenty-five (25) Miles per Hour zone to 30 Miles per Hour from its most southerly intersection with Cambridge Road (No. 306) to its most northerly intersection with Cambridge Road.
2. Add a speed limit on Palmer Drive (No. 424) thirty-five miles per hour for the entire length of the road.


Fiscal Impact:

DELETE:

ADD:

“(cm) Knollwood Drive (No. 315) thirty (30) miles per hour from its most southerly intersection with Cambridge Road (No. 306) to its most northerly intersection with Cambridge Road.”

“(fd) Palmer Drive (No. 424) thirty-five (35) miles per hour for the entire length of the road.”




