Recommendation:

On June 27, 2006, Item #29, your Board authorized the Sheriff to sign the application with the Governor's Office of Homeland Security for the 2006 Homeland Security Grant in the amount of \$394,653. The Sheriff has received notification for the State Office of Homeland Security that the application has been approved. Your Board is requested to approve the attached budget transfers increasing the Sheriff's federal revenue in the amount of \$394,653 and increasing expenditure appropriations in multiple categories by \$394,653.

Reason for Recommendation:

The FY 2006 Homeland Security Grant program includes funding for two distinct programs – the State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP) and the Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program (LETPP). The SHSP provides funding for planning, equipment, training, exercises and management/administrative costs. The LETPP provides funds to support various law enforcement prevention activities, including information sharing, target hardening, treat recognition and interoperable communications. All Operational Areas (an OES geographical designator) will receive a minimum combined base amount of \$50,000 with the remaining funds distributed based on population. El Dorado County will receive \$216,686 for SHSP; \$177,967 for LETPP for a total allocation of \$394,653.00.

Fiscal Impact:

None. These funds will be added to the Sheriff's FY2006/2007 budget and there is no County match required.

Action to be Taken Following Approval:

The Auditor will post the approved budget transfers adding \$394,653 in federal revenue and \$394,653 in expenditures in the Sheriff's FY2006/2007 budget.
