

Letter of Intent Comprehensive Drug Court Implementation Adult Drug Court Programs Fiscal Year 2006-07

A letter of intent on the additional \$4.0 million for funding CDCI adult drug court programs is requested by the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP). The letter of intent is not binding on either the county or ADP. The letter of intent offers an opportunity for the county to identify their ability to expend their additional allocation and/or their need for an increased allocation. Failure to submit a letter of intent disqualifies the county from being considered for the additional \$4.0 million for CDCI adult drug court programs.
