## **RE:** Request for \$10,000 County Portion of Funding for 56-Acre Planning Charette with City of South Lake Tahoe

The City of South Lake Tahoe and El Dorado County have come together to explore possible recreational and cultural enhancements to the 56-acre recreation area in the middle of town. The goal is to optimize use of this space for residents and visitors.

This 56-acre area encompasses a number of City and County uses; including, El Dorado Beach, Campground by the Lake, the City Ice Arena and Recreation Complex, the County Library and the structures that house the Chamber of Commerce, Senior Center, and Arts Building. This area is the subject of consideration for four internationally acclaimed design groups, which have developed and presented concepts for improving public use and access.

The four design teams – Design Workshop, EDAW, Foothill Associates and Royston, Hanamoto, Alley and Abbey – participated in a 3-day design competition, bringing a range of professional expertise together to collaborate and create effective solutions to this multi-faceted project. The competition resulted in the selection of a planning and design team to work with the community, the City and the County over the next 12 to 18 months to develop plans for improvements to this important public area. The California Tahoe Conservancy is expected to provide significant funding to hire the winning team.

The public attended and participated in this three-day process. Beginning Wednesday, October 4 at 1:00 p.m., the design teams developed concepts for this community-based recreation project. Teams worked at Inn by the Lake, the Ice Arena, the Recreation Center and the Senior Center through Friday morning. The public viewed works in progress and asked questions during this time. Public presentation of the conceptual plans was held at 2:30 pm on Friday, October 6 at the new Lake Tahoe Community College Library.
