Recommendations:

The Department of Transportation (DOT) recommends the Board of Supervisors (Board):

Adopt a new Resolution to amend the term portion of Resolutions #282-97 (attached) and No. 364-2003 (attached) respectively. The Department is requesting by this proposed Resolution, that the Board extend the order deadline for the removal of all poles, overhead wires, and associated overhead structures from December 31, 2006 to December 31, 2008, as originally stipulated in Resolution No. 282-97 and as amended in Resolution No. 364-2003, and in accordance with Section 12.36.110 et seq. of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code.

Reason for Recommendation:

Due to the complexities associated with the Green Valley Widening Project (Project) as a whole, the Underground Utility District portion of the Project was split into three separate undergrounding phases in an effort to deliver the project elements more efficiently. Phase 1 of the District encompasses Green Valley Road from Brown's Ravine to Francisco Drive and was completed in 1998. Phase 2 of the District encompasses Green Valley Road from County line to Mormon Island Drive and was completed in 2004.

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Phase 3 of the District encompasses Green Valley Road between Mormon Island Drive and Brown's Ravine and is currently under construction as part of the Green Valley Road Widening - County Line to Francisco Drive Project, Contract No. 72355 with a proposed completion date in 2008. The two year time extension proposed under the above referenced Resolution would allow adequate time for completion of the final phase of the Underground Utility District.

Fiscal Impact:

There is no fiscal impact if the proposed Resolution is adopted.

Net County Cost:

There is no net cost to the County General Fund associated with this agenda item.

Action to be Taken Following Approval:

The Board Chairman will sign, and the Department will implement, the proposed subject Resolution.

AMENDING THE TERM FOR THE COMPLETION OF THE UNDERGROUND IMPROVEMENTS AS ORIGINALLY STIPULATED IN RESOLUTION No. 282-97 (FORMING GREEN VALLEY ROAD UNDERGROUND UTILITY DISTRICT) AND AMENDING RESOLUTION No. 364-2003

WHEREAS, on December 16, 1997, the Board of Supervisors declared by Resolution No. 282-97, an Underground Utility District be formed and designated the district the Green Valley Road Underground Utility District; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors ordered the removal of all poles, overhead wires and associated overhead structures within the Green Valley Road Underground Utility District on or before December 31, 2006; and

WHEREAS, Phase 1 of the Green Valley Road Underground Utility District work from Browns Ravine to Francisco Drive was completed in 1998; and

WHEREAS, Phase 2 of the Green Valley Road Underground Utility District work from County Line to Mormon Island Drive was completed in 2004; and

WHEREAS, Phase 3 of the Green Valley Road Underground Utility District work from Mormon Island Drive to Browns Ravine is currently under construction as part of the Green Valley Road Widening - County Line to Francisco Drive Project, Contract No. 72355 with a proposed completion date in 2008; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Supervisors of the County of El Dorado that:

Pursuant to Section 12.36.110 et seq. of the El Dorado County Ordinance Code, the Board of Supervisors does hereby extend and therefore fix December 31, 2008 as the date by which affected property owners must be ready to receive underground service and does hereby extend the order of removal of all poles, overhead wires, and associated overhead structures and the underground installation of wires and facilities for supplying electric, communication, or similar or associated services within the Green Valley Road Underground Utility District to be on or before December 31, 2008.
