Recommendation

The Department of Transportation (DOT) recommends that the Board of Supervisors:

- 1) Authorize DOT to claim its allocation of TDA Article 8 Funds for FY 2006/2007; and
- 2) Direct the Chairman to sign the authorizing resolution.

Reason for Recommendation

On June 1, 2006 the El Dorado County Transportation Commission (EDCTC) adopted Resolution #05/06.31 allocating \$293,730.60 in Local Transportation Funds (LTF) to El Dorado County Department of Transportation, to be used for Article 8 purposes.

Article 8 of the TDA permits counties to file claims for local streets and roads projects. DOT proposes to use this funding to help finance routine road maintenance projects.

Fiscal Impact

These funds will provide additional funding for routine road maintenance. A total of \$293,730.60 has been included in the FY 2006/2007 budget.

RESOLUTION OF THE EL DORADO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION FINAL FISCAL YEAR 2006/07 APPORTIONMENT AND ALLOCATION OF THE EL DORADO COUNTY TRANSPORTATION DEVELOPMENT ACT LOCAL TRANSPORTATION FUND

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Transportation Commission is the responsible agency for transportation planning for the Western Slope of El Dorado County and responsible for the administration of the Transportation Development Act of 1971, as amended thereafter; and

WHEREAS, the County of El Dorado, the City of Placerville and the El Dorado County Transit Authority are each required to file annual transportation claims for the funds from the Local Transportation Fund of the Western Slope of the County, as apportioned to them by the El Dorado County Transportation Commission, pursuant to the Act; and

WHEREAS, it is the responsibility of the El Dorado County Transportation Commission, under the provisions of the Act, to review the annual transportation claims and to make allocations of monies from the Local Transportation Fund based on the estimated revenue upon approving said claim; and

WHEREAS, the Auditor of said County is instructed to pay monies in the fund to the claimants pursuant to allocation instructions received from the El Dorado County Transportation Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the El Dorado County Transportation Commission shall review the claims as they are received, approve same for the 2006/07 Fiscal Year funds estimated to be available in the Local Transportation Fund, and make the following allocations:

- 1. To the County of El Dorado Auditor-Controller for administrative costs, to be paid only once from the entire County's fund prior to apportioning the County Local Transportation Fund in the amount of \$4,000.00, per Section 99233.1.
- 2. To the El Dorado County Transportation Commission for TDA administration and for planning and programming in the amount of \$370,970.81, per Section 99233.2.
- 3. Reservation for pedestrian and bicycle facilities purposes for local agencies as programmed and claimed in the amount of \$72,337.56, per Section 99233.3 & 99234.
- 4. To the El Dorado County Transit Authority for Article 4 purposes, the total amount available of \$3,965,013.00, per Sections 99233.8, 99260(a) and 99262.
- 5. To the City of Placerville (7.463% of total El Dorado County population), for Article 8 purposes, the total amount available of \$23,689.03, per Sections 99233.9, 99400(a), 99402 and 99407.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, The El Dorado County Transportation Commission has requested that approved claims are to be paid in full, provided the money available, and provided that the Commission has properly expended prior Local Transportation Funds at the beginning of the Fiscal Year.

The El Dorado County Transit Authority's claim is to have priority for full payment, followed by the El Dorado County Transportation Commission's claim.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that allocation instructions shall be prepared for each claimant in accordance with the above, and pursuant to the El Dorado County Transportation Commission rules and regulations, the Executive Director, appointed by the Commission is authorized to sign the allocation instructions and to issue the instructions to the County Auditor to pay the claimants in accordance with the above allocations and conditions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the claimants are to be notified by the El Dorado County Transportation Commission of action on their claims.
