AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES # AGMT 04-607 Amendment I

THIS AMENDMENT I to that Agreement for Services # AGMT 04-607 made and entered into by and between the County of El Dorado, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as "County"), and Stantec Consulting Inc., an Arizona corporation duly qualified to conduct business in the State of California, whose corporate headquarters address is 200, 10160-112 Street, Edmonton AB, Canada T5K 2L6; and whose local office address is 2590 Venture Oaks Way, Sacramento, CA 95833, (hereinafter referred to as "Consultant");

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, Consultant has been engaged by County to assist the Department of Transportation on an as-needed basis with planning, design, project management, and project delivery services for erosion control/water quality projects in the Tahoe Basin in conjunction with the Environmental Improvement Program pursuant to Agreement for Services # AGMT 04-607, incorporated herein and made by reference a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend Agreement for Services # AGMT 04-607 to correct references to the Tahoe Engineering Unit to the Tahoe Engineering Division; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend Agreement for Services # AGMT 04-607 to extend the expiration date to December 31, 2007, amending ARTICLE II Term; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend Agreement for Services # AGMT 04-607 to increase the compensation for services by \$3,232,000; to include Consultant's current Fee Schedule; and to change the address to which invoices shall be mailed, amending ARTICLE III Compensation for Services; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend Agreement for Services # AGMT 04-607 to change the Notice to Parties recipients, amending ARTICLE XV Notice to Parties; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereto desire to amend Agreement for Services #AGMT 04-607 to change the Contract Administrator, amending ARTICLE XXV Contract Administrator;

NOW, THEREFORE, County and Consultant mutually agree to amend the terms of the Agreement in this Amendment I to Agreement for Services # AGMT 04-607 to read as follows:

ARTICLE II

Term: This Agreement shall become effective when fully executed by both parties hereto and shall expire December 31, 2007.

ARTICLE III

Compensation for Services:

- A. For services provided herein, including all deliverables described in the individual Task Orders, County agrees to pay Consultant within thirty (30) days following County receipt and approval of itemized invoice(s) detailing services rendered. For the purposes hereof, the billing rate shall be in accordance with Exhibit A, marked "Fee Schedule," incorporated herein and made by reference a part hereof. Pursuant to Exhibit A, adjusted rates effective January 1, 2005 through December 31, 2007 are included herewith as Exhibit A-1, marked "Revised Fee Schedule," incorporated herein and made by reference a part hereof. In accordance with the provisions of Exhibit A and Exhibit A-1, rates shall be adjusted each January 1st by a factor of 3% upwards. Exhibit A-1 indicates rates for 2005 through 2007, inclusive of the 3% increases. The total amount payable by County for an individual Task Order shall not exceed the amount agreed to in the Task Order, unless the Contract Administrator and Consultant's Project Manager amend the Task Order. The total amount of this Agreement, as amended, shall not exceed \$3,982,000, inclusive of all work of subconsultants and expenses.
- B. Mileage Expenses: Mileage expenses shall be paid in accordance with Section C of this Article III and with County's Travel Policy (No. D-1), Section 5b, attached hereto as Exhibit B, marked "Board of Supervisors Policy," incorporated herein and made by reference a part hereof.
- C. For project-related Task Orders, County agrees to pay for travel hours and mileage expenses, based on an approved budget in accordance with Article I, Section B. For staff augmentation services, Consultant is expected to report to DOT's TED office in South Lake Tahoe, California, or directly to a construction project site, as applicable, based on a mutually agreeable schedule and will not be compensated for travel hours or mileage expenses. Travel costs (i.e., overnight lodging, meals, parking, etc.) will not be reimbursed for any services performed under this Agreement.
- D. Itemized invoices shall follow the format specified by County and shall reference this Agreement Number and project title, and shall include County's work order number and task code, both on their face and on any enclosures or back-up documentation. Invoices shall be mailed to the Contract Administrator at the following address:

ARTICLE XV

Notice to Parties: All notices to be given by the parties hereto shall be in writing and served by depositing same in the United States Post office, postage prepaid and return receipt requested. Notices to County shall be in duplicate and addressed as follows:

The Agreement is further amended such that all references to the "Tahoe Engineering Unit" (TEU) shall now read, "Tahoe Engineering Division" (TED).

Except as herein amended, all other parts and sections of Agreement for Services # AGMT 04-607 shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
