The purpose of this letter is to evidence the support of Ethika Foundation for your proposed Runnymeade Terrace 70-unit affordable housing complex to be located near the intersection of Runnymeade Court and El Dorado Road.

I understand that the Board of Supervisors of El Dorado County will conduct a hearing on April 10 to decide if the project can move forward or not. Based on a tour of the site and of the surrounding areas, examination of various planning and design documents and discussions at the most recent county housing task force meeting, my recommendation is for the project to receive full approval by the Supervisors so you can move forward.
