Amendment I

This Amendment I, to that Contract made and entered into on July 1, 2006 by and between the County of El Dorado, a political subdivision of the State of California (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY"), and the El Dorado County Regional Prehospital Emergency Services Operations Authority, (hereinafter referred to as "JPA"), whose principal place of business is 480 Locust Road, Diamond Springs, CA 95619;

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, COUNTY provides prehospital Advanced Life Support (ALS) services and dispatch services under a public utility model to the residents of the County of El Dorado, and the JPA is under contract with COUNTY to provide said services to County Service Area No. 7, pursuant to the provisions of Section 25210.4 (a)(8) of the Government Code of California; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY has completed a thorough analysis of JPA response time compliance during the period January 1-December 31, 2006;

WHEREAS, COUNTY and the JPA agree that it is necessary to revise the response time standards for emergency ambulance services in the current JPA Contract;

NOW, THEREFORE, COUNTY and the JPA do hereby agree to amend this Contract as follows:

SECTION V – STANDARDS OF SERVICE FOR PREHOSPITAL ALS <u>Article XI - Response Time Standards, C. Maximum Response Times</u> is amended as follows:

C. Maximum Response Times

For emergency ambulance responses, the JPA shall be required meet the following maximum response time(s):

Area	Response Time	Compliance Percentage
Urban	11 minutes	90%
Semi-Rural	16 minutes	90%
Rural	24 minutes	90%
Wilderness	90 minutes	90%

Calls dispatched as "Code 2" (i.e., no red lights or siren) per Emergency Medical Dispatch (EMD) protocols, or those where the ambulance is dispatched to a staging location until the scene has been secured by law enforcement units, shall be exempt from meeting the response time requirements above.
