Re: Opposition to the Issuance of Special Use Permit and Support for Re-zoning

ACCORD is a group of Cameron Estates homeowners organized to protect and insure the continued existence of a rural community atmosphere. To that end, ACCORD and its members, while supporting the re-zoning requested by the Light of the Hills Lutheran Church, are opposed to the granting of the Special Use Permit for the Light of the Hills Lutheran Church, file number Z06-0038/S98-0013R, as it is currently written. The portion of the requested revision objected to is "....expansion of the permit to allow the development of a multi-purpose ball field on an adjacent 5.069 acre parcel."

It is our understanding that the Church plans to control access to the ball field with a permit process. Local soccer, softball and baseball leagues will be permitted to use the field for practice, games and tournaments. These activities will have a significant negative impact on the residents of Cameron Estates. The noise and light pollution from these activities will disrupt the peace and tranquility of the community. The traffic impact on Strolling Hills and Coach Lane, already over burdened, will be such that access by residence and emergency equipment will be adversely impacted. Should the special use permit be granted, the practical result will be to turn the parcel into a veritable sports complex within a community which is not designed for such an activity resulting in loss of our way of life and a diminution in property values. ACCORD does not object to the Church developing its property for its own uses, including recreational and is more than willing to work with the Church to develop a plan that will be mutually acceptable while restricting public access.

There are 285 parcels within Cameron Estates. Of those 174 (62%) are voting members of ACCORD. In 2004 a petition (attached) opposing the development of the ball field was circulated and signed by 143 (82%) of ACCORD.

Finally, ACCORD is prepared to take whatever steps are necessary to retain the current community atmosphere while working with our neighbors to allow for reasonable non-residential use of their property.


