


I want to let you know how much I support and favor the installation of a day use ball field at Light of the Hills Lutheran Church in Cameron Park that can be used by organized sports teams.

Our congregation has worked hard to be a helpful member of the community, by making our current building open for meetings and activities, including concerts, 12 step groups, recitals, meetings for several CSDs, and as an outlet for the El Dorado County Food Bank. We believe that the ball field is something our community needs. It is clear to those who live in this part of El Dorado County that there is a shortage of ball fields available for children and youth to use.

The ball field location across from Burke Junction and the Safeway Shopping area is an ideal, central location for the children of communities from El Dorado Hills to Placerville. Ample parking for the ball field is already available in the church parking lot.

It is my understanding that the County Staff report shows that both independent consultants and County staff have studied potential increases to noise and traffic and found that no additional impact is expected from a new ball field on the church property. These are objective studies, not personal opinions. Indeed, there are only two residential parcels that border the church property, and neither home can be seen from the proposed ball field location. One of these two homes can be seen from Highway 50, which brings a much higher level of noise than a ball field would.

We want to support the kids of our community – and I urge you to do the same. Please support the children of these El Dorado Communities by voting in favor of the church's planned ball field at your December 11 Board of Supervisor's meeting.
