On June 30, 2008, this project will be officially closed and no new expenditures may be generated, nor may any additional funded project activities occur. All unexpended and unencumbered funds must be returned by August 30, 2008. This project is allowed 60 days to liquidate encumbrances that were incurred prior to June 30. After the 60-day period, all encumbered funds, which have not been liquidated, must be returned to the State Library.

Timely reporting on financial and program activities is required. The first and second quarter fiscal and narrative reports are being waived for this grant. An interim narrative report and quarterly fiscal report are required and due by April 30, 2008. Final narrative and fiscal reports are also required and due after the close of the project, by July 31, 2008. The final liquidation report, if required, is due and must be submitted by September 15. Thus, all reporting regarding this project must have been received at the State Library by September 15, 2008.

Please note that the required ten percent (10%) of the grant award that is normally withheld until the end of the project period is being waived for this particular grant. Despite this waiver, your library is still responsible for fulfilling all project reporting requirements and expending all funds, or returning all unspent grant funds by the time specified in the grant program. Failure to provide timely reports is a serious breach of a grant recipient's administrative duty under the grant program, which may result in federal audit exceptions against the state and the loss of LSTA funds.
