#### **OPTION III**

### 48 Bed Medium/Maximum Security Housing Similar to OPTION I, without 3<sup>rd</sup> story Housing

#### **PRO**

- Meets most of identified need for medium/maximum housing Provides infrastructure (kitchen/medical/intake, etc) for future addition of Medium/Maximum Housing Unit
- May qualify for AB 900 funding

#### **CON**

- Does not provide for all need (more medium/maximum)
- Not enough minimum security
- No expansion capability
- Does not meet 2015 projection

## OPTION III

Similar to OPTION I, without 3rd story Housing 48 Bed Medium/Maximum Security Housing Staffing

Correctional Officers, Correctional Sergeants, Ultimately need 28 new positions, including Deputy Sheriff (Transportation), Cooks and **Detention Aide** 

Cost: \$2,618,000 /year
