## Recommendation

The Auditor-Controller recommends that the Board of Supervisors receive and file the State Controllers audit of the property tax apportionment and allocation system for the fiscal years July 1, 2002 through June 30, 2006.

## Reason for Recommendation

Pursuant to Government Code Section 12468 the State Controller must audit the property apportionment of a county our size, at a minimum, at least every five years. Their most recently completed audit dated January 31, 2008 is being presented today. Their audit disclosed that El Dorado County complied with all appropriate statutes for the apportionment and allocation of property tax revenues for the audit period. The only finding continues to be the ERAF contributions for the City of Placerville.
