Good afternoon Honorable Supervisors,

Before the June Primary this year, we were one of many local organizations who expressed concern that Measure E, as written, would adversely impact a whole range of important projects and uses – farmers and ranch marketing activities, parks and services, moderate income housing, small businesses and job creation. Collectively, we said that Measure E violated a whole range of laws, was inconsistent with the General Plan and would lead the County into costly litigation.

Measure E proponents dismissed these concerns and painted all opposition as developers or developer "shills".

County staff has reviewed Measure E in a Staff Report which was presented to you (The Board of Supervisors) on your August 9, 2016 meeting. The report suggests Measure E cannot be implemented, as written, because provisions are "potentially unconstitutional" or inconsistent with the General Plan. Measure E creates requirements that cannot be met.

Staff reports the county has a duty to revise the language of Measure E, so that it is implemented, not as written, but to avoid the dire consequences we and others warned of in the beginning.

If Measure E can be implemented as written and approved by voters, then do so. However, if Measure E cannot be implemented as written and approved by voters, then let the courts decide.
