Dear Supervisors Mikulaco, Frentzen, Veerkamp, Ranalli, and Novasel,

The voters expect ALL of Measure E to be implemented as intended. That includes the provision that the county use Caltrans data to analyze level of service on US 50.

I was present at the Board meeting last year during which it was amply demonstrated that the County is either unable or unwilling to provide traffic data that bears any resemblance to the reality county residents experience. Do we need to do it again in court?

County voters may not understand the complexities of land use policy, but they do understand traffic, and most of us have experienced Level of Service F on 50 on many occasions. That's why Measure E passed. This is one area where any attempt to pull a fast one behind closed doors simply will not work.

Please direct staff to implement Measure E as written, in full, and as the voters intended. And please bear in mind that every communication like this you receive speaks not just for the writer, but for dozens of residents who do not have the time or inclination to communicate with you, but who agree with the content. We who speak up are just the tip of a large and growing iceberg.
