Board of Supervisors,

The Measure E committee requests that the Board of Supervisors postpone the October 28th Board Directed "workshop" and any action regarding Measure E, Level of Service, Capital Improvement Plan or Traffic Mitigation items until several basic conflicts can be resolved.

According to staff, it sounds like this is just going to be a repeat of the October 10th meeting at the El Dorado Hills Fire station. A major concern is that it is being called a workshop. A workshop would be a collaborative action among interested parties without a preconceived conclusion. I would call the October 10th meeting a "presentation" which Shawna Purvine happened to introduce as just that: a presentation. I was surprised when Claudia Wade stated that that meeting was a result of the Board action to have a workshop on LOS and Measure E. Especially since no one on the Measure E committee was notified - and there was nothing in the County's email notices or on the agenda stating it had to do with Measure E (see image).

Placerville, CA – The County of El Dorado will be holding a workshop to discuss Traffic Level of Service and the County's Travel Demand Model. The workshops will provide an opportunity for the public to ask questions of a panel of County Long Range Planning Staff, Caltrans and other traffic engineers regarding the industry practice of determining Level of Service and how the Travel Demand Model plays a role.

The workshop will be held on the following date and time:

It is very disturbing to see that Supervisor Frentzen's request for a different 'workshop' date was rejected so that Steve Pedretti could wrap up this item before leaving the County. Supervisor Frenzten has been the most accountable and responsive representative on the Board and her presence is sorely needed by the public she serves. Why would the County schedule the meeting to accommodate an outgoing employee rather than schedule to attain a full Board for such an important issue?

Since this seems to be just a "presentation" on the 28th, what purpose or meaning will this meeting really have? Will it be used for future Board decisions? The concern remains of how the County is using Caltrans data to determine Highway 50 traffic level of service. Without the opportunity for a joint meeting with Caltrans, the County, and the Measure E committee, disagreement of the validity of the County's methodology will continue. Therefore, the request to resolve the issue of how the County is using Caltrans data incorrectly has yet to be officially addressed and the meeting on October 28 needs to be postponed until this issue is settled.
