RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Information Technologies Division of the Chief Administrative Office recommending the Board:

 Make findings that it is more economical and feasible to utilize an outside contractor for the provision of Telecommunications Equipment maintenance in accordance with County Ordinance 3.13.030;

 Approve the Avaya General Conditions of Maintenance Services, Channel Service Agreement Order Form and Service Agreement Supplement (10-1-2004 through 9-30-2008); and,

Authorize the Chairman to execute the agreements.

REASONS FOR RECOMMENDATIONS:

El Dorado County has used 9 Avaya Definity switches for approximately 10 years. These 9 switches provide all telephone communications in El Dorado County facilities. This equipment has been maintained by Avaya, Inc. (formerly Lucent Technologies, Inc.) since 1999 under a previous agreement. These switches are approaching the end of their service life. Avaya has announced within the next 3.5 years they will no longer support the G3I central processing units within the Definity switches. Committing to a 4-year service agreement ensures El Dorado County's voice communications infrastructure will be in service through October of 2008. A 4-year service agreement is crucial to the County, in that it gives us adequate time to prepare for the replacement of this very costly equipment prior to

the expiration of this agreement. This new agreement reduces our per port/per month charges by \$.03 per port/month and is approximately \$.20 less per port/month than initial price quotes obtained in July of 2004. We currently have 3,750 ports in use.

The County's contract with Avaya expired September 29, 2004. Information Technologies has been working with the vendor since April of 2004 and was prepared to bring this matter to the Board on October 19, 2004. At the last minute a minor discrepancy was found in an Avaya Utility Addendum to our original agreement with Avaya. When asked to correct the discrepancy, Avaya rescinded the Utility Addendum and advised Information technologies they would not agree to any of terms contained in our original agreement #232-S9911. Avaya then sent our department their standard agreements.

Information Technologies worked with Avaya for quite some time negotiating the technical language contained in the Avaya agreements before they met our requirements. The agreements were then forwarded to Purchasing and County Counsel for legal review. Avaya made very few concessions to Purchasing and County Counsel.

County Counsel has given conditional approval to the new Avaya agreements and asked that the Board be aware of the following items:

- 1) Avaya's agreement contains Limits of Liability.
- Avaya reserves the right to assign the contract in some instances without the permission of the County.
- 3) Certain fees per these agreements for additional work are not defined or specified.

Information Technologies has reviewed these items and feels the benefits of this agreement outweigh the potential issues cited by County Counsel, as referenced above.

During the negotiation process, Avaya agreed to place a hold on billing the County for services and agreed to maintain our equipment until the new agreements were negotiated and executed. The County is currently two billing cycles in arrears. Upon approval by the Board, the Information Technologies will process these Avaya invoices.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The total cost for existing network devices on maintenance for one-year is approximately \$67,500 and will vary slightly based on ports in use. Total ports currently in use total approximately 3,750. Information Technologies has budgeted for a maximum of 4,000 ports and is requesting the maximum annual payment to Avaya is set at an amount not-to-exceed \$77,520 per year for the duration of the contract.

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NET COUNTY COST:

No change in Net County cost. Funds are budgeted within the IT FY04/05 equipment maintenance budget.

ACTION TO BE TAKEN FOLLOWING APPROVAL:

Upon full execution of the agreement, Information Technologies will forward copies to the Purchasing Agent for encumbrance in an amount not-to-exceed \$77,520 annually for the duration of the 4-year agreement.
