RESUBMISSION

Attached is the above referenced Amendment for your review and approval. This is the version that incorporates Trish Beck's June 18th revisions and is the version that was sent to the Board for signature (approved on consent June 24th regular meeting; item #8¹) with the signatures of the Caltrans Attorney and the Accounting Administrator. Copies of the original Cooperative Agreement (AGMT 06-1132) and the Contract Routing Sheet indicating Counsel's approval are also attached for reference.

The purpose of this Amendment is to extend the expiration date of the Agreement from June 30, 2008 to December 31, 2012; to delete the State's retention of 10% (\$20,000) of the RTIP-TE funds; and to clarify the notification and handling responsibilities of hazardous materials that may be discovered. This version also incorporates Trish's revisions to the originally submitted Amendment, including the survival clause issue of the State's indemnification of the County in Section II, Article 12.

Also attached for reference are copies of Trish's June 18th email regarding the revisions and the original version of the Amendment that was attached to Legistar #08-0137.
