STR Rate Adjustment Request

On May 28, 2008, STR formally requested:

- A rate increase of 4.33%
- 2.7% increase Lockwood Landfill disposal costs
- 1.4% for fuel increases
- 0.23% for applicable franchise fees

STR Rate Adjustment Request

Disposal – Three Rate Increases by Lockwood April 2007 – 5.3% April 2008 – 4.9% Sept 2008 – 9.6% (per letter of intent from Lockwood Landfill)

Fuel Surcharge
Cost of fuel has increased 19.9%

Franchise Fees 0.23% applicable franchise fees




History of Rate Increases


2005 -9% increase for operations
