EXHIBIT A Evaluation Design for El Dorado County's Las Decisiones Seguras Project

The Decisiones Seguras (Safer Choices) Project is a universal prevention program targeting Latino families in El Dorado County. Based on the Sembrando Salud program, it is a culturally sensitive, community-based alcohol and other drug prevention program for Latino adolescents and their families. The program is designed to improve parent-child communication skills as a way of improving and maintaining healthy decision-making. Designed for youth 11 to 16 years of age, the 8-week curriculum is delivered by bilingual staff in community settings. The program has also been shown to favorably affect youth participants' rates of alcohol and other drug use and their attitudes toward and perception of risk regarding the use of alcohol and other drugs.

Described below are the data collection methods that will be used to collect needed outcome data and the frequency with which each data element will be collected.
