As requested, the Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA) has prepared information regarding the Senior Nutrition Program at the Cameron Park Community Services District Community Center.

The estimated total net County cost to add .33 Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Meal-Site Coordinator to staff
the Senior Nutrition Program at the Cameron Park Community Services District Community Center
during the Monday and Friday lunch service from February 1, 2017 through June 30, 2017, is
approximately \$6500. The estimate assumes the following:

The projected annual cost increase to add .33 Full Time Equivalent (FTE) Meal-Site Coordinator to staff the Senior Nutrition Program at the Cameron Park Community Services District Community Center during the Monday and Friday lunch service from July 1, 2017 through June 30, 2018, is approximately \$21,300. The estimate assumes the following:

The current program operates under a non-financial Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Food Bank of El Dorado County and the Cameron Park Community Services District and establishes the roles and responsibilities of the Health and Human Services Agency, the Food Bank of El Dorado County and the Cameron Park Community Services District for the provision of congregate meal services under the Elderly Nutrition Program. The Senior Nutrition Program has been providing meals two days a week, to those eligible seniors in a group setting. The Food Bank of El Dorado County is withdrawing its involvement effective February 1, 2017. The current estimate annual costs are as follows:
