The addition of the road from Green Valley Road East of the Morman Island (existing traffic from the Arroya Vista community from Malcolm Dixon Road (near Salmon Falls). It should be installed at this intersection in order to allow the traffic to access Green Valley Road. As stated by the Fir only once access route would not be approved with current regulations.
