Where is the specifics of the dimensions of the intersection? From either the original, or revised proposal? There is no way that an effected neighbor or member of the public can know how this development may impact them without information regarding the specific dimensions and extent of the necessary intersection improvements. We don't want another "no turn on red" situation like happened at the Mo Flat over crossing for west bound off ramp turns onto north bound Mo Flat.

Without these specifics, approval of this revision is a gross violation of the intent of the Development Agreement process, as well as the intent and purpose of the environmental review process.
