
**RE:** Sworn Officer Weapon Purchase / Change in Surplus Recipient

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On August 18, 2014, Chief Probation Officer Brian Richart directed the Department to change its state issued service weapon system from a Glock model 22 Generation 3 (Gen3) to the Glock model 22 Generation 4 (Gen4) system. This change was made as the Gen4 system has several factory upgraded features and the ability to size the handgun grip to better accommodate the physical differences in our officers. This weapons systems change to the Gen4 system occurred on April 1, 2015. When the surplus request was originally submitted, all Gen3 firearms were to be surplusled for buy-back from Proforce Law Enforcement for \$290.00.

Pursuant to Public Contract Code Section 10334(c), several of our Probation Officers requested in writing to purchase their previously issued Gen3 firearm. Therefore, this Memo and Board Item is to request changing some of the surplusled firearms from Proforce Law Enforcement to the officers who made a request to purchase their previously issued firearm. Please see the attached surplus form for the serial numbers of the firearms to be sold to a Probation Officer instead of Proforce Law Enforcement.
