1) Provide a brief description of the proposed project(s) that you plan to implement with city/county payment program funds. Public Resources Code 14581 (a)(3)(B).

Project Description:

El Dorado County Community Development Agency Environmental Management Division (CDA/EMD) operates a littler abatement crew. The purpose of the crew is to remove discarded debris from along the roadways and respond to complaints of illegal dump sites throughout the County. CDA/EMD will apply El Dorado County's portion of this grant funding to purchase one new litter abatement crew truck to replace a truck that has over 120,000 miles. The truck that needs to be replaced is approximately 13 years old (2003) and is increasingly in need of costly repairs to maintain safety and operability. Funds will also be used to equip the new truck with safety and functional features including: hazard lights, racks for the bed of the truck, rails to carry safety cones and roadway work signs, etc. CDA/EMD plans to use any remaining City/County Grant funds for the following:

- CDA/EMD has collaborated with waste haulers and members of our community to develop an El Dorado County Recycling logo. This logo will be used to implement a County wide recycling education and outreach campaign. The logo is planned to be placed on public recycling bins throughout the County and in education and outreach materials. Grants funds will be used for printing this educational and outreach material (stickers and signs to be placed on recycling bins, window clings to be distributed to businesses to help promote AB 341 Mandatory Commercial Recycling, etc.).
- Placement of beverage container recycling bins at select gas stations throughout the County. Gas Stations will be selected based on highly populated areas and their staff's willingness to manage and recycle the collected beverage containers and report back to CDA/EMD.
