Dear Supervisor Frentzen,

Please continue making a recommendation "to staff to begin formal discussions with the Shingle Springs Band of Miwok Indians to expand the boundary within which Local Tribe funds may be used" to a later date so that the public has time to engage in the discussion.

Changing the boundary of the map would divert the intended use of the funds to mitigate the impacts of the casino. The agenda item was not written in a way that the public would be aware that the Tribe Funds are being considered for diversion.

Diverting a funding source should be a transparent process and there was no way for the public to see on the agenda that the Tribe Funds were going to be discussed or that staff is seeking direction to renegotiate the boundary map. If the agenda item had been written as below (addition in red), then the public would have been properly notified of staff's recommendation to divert the funds.

Please continue this item as part of the County's pursuit of good governance for open and transparent process.
