• A parklet is a small public area that transforms a former parking space into a public recreation area.

• Sponsored by El Dorado County's Health and Human Services Agency (HHSA), Public Health Division.


• A direct result of the Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP).

• Parklets encourage physical activity through non-motorized transportation by providing pedestrians with amenities like public seating, landscaping, art and bicycle parking.




Over half of adults and

fewer than a quarter of adolescents in El Dorado County are

overweight or obese.

The odds of a **child** being **obese** or **overweight** were found to be 20-60 percent **higher** among children living in neighborhoods with unfavorable social conditions, **no access** to sidewalks, parks, and recreation centers.
