- A direct result of the Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP).


- Project was intended to be driven by our community, engage our youth, promote design excellence and deliver a new space that encourages a healthy lifestyle.
- o The theme is "Healthy Living" and the competition asked High School students to be inspired to submit proposals that were innovative, creative and resourceful.


HEALTHY LIVING PARKLET UPDATE

- We had 30 students participate from 3 High Schools.

 - Adventist High School
- We received 21 unique parklet design submissions.
- The top 3 designs were posted on welldorado.org for the community to vote.
- We received over 1,600 votes!

HEALTHY LIVING PARKLET TOP 3 DESIGNS





