My name is Robin Smay, and I am the neighbor immediately to the north of the business in Coloma known as Villa Florentina. This letter shares the documentation and data that I unfortunately felt the need to collect to document ongoing noncompliance with the terms of this business's special use permit. The data establish that throughout the entirety of the operating season, there were multiple permit violations at each event that prevented me from the reasonable use and enjoyment of my property. Due to ongoing and egregious violations, it is my request that events be reduced or eliminated, that amplified music no longer be allowable for the business, or at very least that absolute compliance with the originally proposed parameters of operation be enforced, with revocation resulting from any continued noncompliance, including any use of the unpermitted and unstudied lawn expansion.

As a special education administrator, I work long hours during the week, and live in Coloma to enjoy the quiet and relaxation usually possible there. My home is my greatest investment, and the neighboring business has not only compromised my ability to enjoy my home, but also my property value. I did not have any desire to take data every weekend during the Spring and Summer of 2016, and lost precious free time to do so, but felt this was the only avenue I had to protect my interests. I recognize the documentation attached may seem excessive, but I have never been a situation like this before and don't know how to best defend myself, nor what is required to establish "substantial evidence" of noncompliance. Between the cost of acoustical study and representation, an attorney to guide me through this process, and a permitted fence between my home and the unpermitted lawn expansion of Villa Florentina, I will have invested $\$ 12,000$. to protect my home and interests. I should not have to bear ongoing costs or further data collection efforts to protect my rights as a Coloma resident and property owner.

The initial charts attached show violations that occurred at the end of the event season, even after multiple contacts from neighbors, three letters from the planning department, and a letter from my attorney. They offer a clear graphic representation of violations like those that ocurred throughout the season. Following are photos of the original site as studied and approved, and of the unapproved expansion of the staging site, doubling the staging space of the property. The remainder of the packet is chronological, and shows my personal attempts at working with the owner toward compliance, as well as the noncompliance that continued throughout the event season during all events held.

Thank you for considering this submission, and I am hopeful that the attached documentation provides a picture of my considerable efforts in solving the issues that are ongoing with this business.

Pursuant to your request, Bollard Acoustical Consultants, Inc. (BAC) conducted noise compliance monitoring of the Villa Florentina Wedding Venue located at 6673 Carvers Road, adjacent to your property. The measurements were conducted from November 5-6, 2016, with the intent of identifying any noise exceedances relative to the El Dorado County noise standards during the event held at Villa Florentina on Saturday, November 5. The El Dorado County General Plan establishes the following noise standards for non-transportation noise sources affecting residential uses:

Because the project parcel and adjacent parcels are rural in nature, the rural noise standards shown in Table 1 would apply at a position 100 feet from the residence. In this case, the property line adjacent to the wedding venue is less than 100 feet from the residence, so measurements were conducted at the property line. In addition, because the noise source is event music and human voices, the noise standards shown in Table 1 are reduced a further 5 dB pursuant to the first footnote of the table.

Noise measurement equipment included a Larson Davis Laboratories (LDL) Model 831 precision integrating sound level meter, calibrated on-site with an LDL CAL200 calibrator to ensure the accuracy of the measurements. The meter was set to record audio files to allow for the identification of noise sources.

The results of the noise measurements are presented in Attachment $A$. Attachment A-1 shows the measured noise levels on Saturday, when the Villa Florentina event occurred, and Attachment A-2 shows ambient levels from the following day to provide a point of comparison. As indicated in Attachment A , the ambient noise levels measured on Sunday were typically lower than the El Dorado County rural noise standards even with the speech/music offset applied. Occasional $L_{\text {max }}$ exceedances were recorded, and were identified to be caused by birds and other environmental sources during analysis of the audio files. The noise levels measured on Saturday exceeded both the $L_{\text {eq }}$ and $L_{\text {max }}$ standards for the duration of the event (approximately $2: 15 \mathrm{PM}$ to $9: 45 \mathrm{PM}$ ). Exceedances during this time ranged up to +18 dB relative to the $L_{\text {eq }}$ standard and +28 dB relative to the $L_{\text {max }}$ standard, and were all confirmed to result from voices and music during analysis of the audio files.

This analysis concludes that the Villa Florentina Wedding Venue did not comply with the El Dorado County noise standards during the monitoring period. Please contact BAC at (916) 663-0500 or paulb@bacnoise.com with any questions.

I am one of your next door neighbors here on Carvers Rd., and I am sorry that my first contact is not simply a friendly introduction as I would prefer. I am sure that since this evening is your first wedding, you are still working out kinks and figuring out how to manage each event. I am not sure if you are aware of the mandated location of any amplified sound equipment per the permit for your location. Per the permit, and speakers and amplified music equipment are required to be within the covered/ surrounded patio area immediately in the middle of the home only, as was recommended per the sound study held prior to the issuing of your business permit. This is to shield and minimize the carrying of sound to surrounding properties (sound impact to my property was studied and found to be the greatest of all the surrounding homes). ## 5/7/2016 Villa Florentina Noise Violations

Requested that speaker placed on "Lawn Terrace" be removed to comply with permit. Response from owner was that this speaker would not be moved, that he would just appeal to planning commission to allow it moving forward. While I did not take pictures of my decibel meter during the ceremony, readings were in the 70 s and 80 s for ceremony music.

While owner assured me lawn speaker would not be used for DJ'ed music, it was. It was directly facing my property and located less than 50 feet from my front porch. When I recognized that there would be no effort to comply with permit parameters (at about 8:30pm), I called EDSO, who showed up at about 9:30, and did not check speaker locations or decibel levels.

Overall decibel levels throughout event were brought down from previous weeks. Some periods of compliance. However, there was continued location of speakers (even during dancing/ evening portion) in violation of permit, and continued decibel violations, though to a less degree then during the last two events.

Speaker tested on lawn about 1:52pm. Music on lawn tested as well for ceremony. Music being played from the lawn for the ceremony. Only 115 guests, so not as much patron noise as previous larger events.

Music and vows both amplified during ceremony. While volumes were reduced from, and length of ceremony was shorter than, other events this season, decibel maximums were still exceeded, particularly by music being played from unpermitted location. While recent communication from owner considers location of speaker on lawn a "gray area" in the permit (Bollard Acoustical study and permit are very clear and not at all gray re: location of sound equipment), the decibel allowances for commercial activity in a rural residential neighborhood are not at all "gray," and are violated by use of such a speaker on the lawn, particularly for music.

There was a period post ceremony (about 4:45-6:45) when decibels were much more moderated than at previous events. Based on quality of music sound, music was being played from the permitted location (dance floor) at this time, which significantly mitigated impact.

At about 6:45, music started to be played by speakers located outside the designated dance floor area (against permit parameters), out closer to the fountain. As when this has happened on other occasions, the music is directed into my backyard without the barrier the house creates when speakers are on the dancefloor. When speakers are so located, decibel readings are even higher in the back yard than they are on my porch. Decibel violations markedly increased at this time.

Shortly after 9:00pm, music volume was cut back, with no decibel violations after 9:05pm. Music stopped promptly at 9:30.

## Re: Use Permit Violations

Dear Mr. Anderson:

Robin Smay has contacted me seeking advice on her rights and remedies regarding your compliance with the conditions of the use permit for your operations at Villa Florentine. Based on my discussions with Robin, County staff and my own investigation, it is clear that your "special events" are not being conducted in accordance with the use permit. Accordingly, you are in violation of the use permit and. further, your conduct on the property constitutes an illegal nuisance, making it impossible for Robin to enjoy the use of her property during such special events. Unless you cease having special events. or bring your operation in compliance with the use permit conditions, you may be subject to a revocation of your use permit or an injunction issued by the court preventing events such as those you have been conducting.

Robin has mede nt cleat wo me that she does not wish 10 prevent your reasonable use of the property and that if you conducted your events within the physical parameters and sound mitigation as outlined in the use permit. she would withdraw any objections to your operation. I have spoken to County staff and am aware that they have begun enforcement proceedings under the County's authority to enforce the conditions of the use permit. It is our intention at this time to monitor the County's actions and participate in any hearings that may be conducted as part of an enforcement action and take independent legal action only if the County's process does not result in a satisfactory outcome.

Based on my review of the correspondence between Robin and yourself, it is clear that Robin has made every effort to resolve this situation without the involvement of the County or seeking other drastic remedies. She continues to be committed to maintaining a cordial relationship with you as a neighbor, but feels compelled at this time to protect her property rights and value.

Robin sincerely hopes that your will comply with the terms of your use permit as called for by the County's Development Services Division and get this unpleasantness behind you.

It has been fun, exciting and most of all educational. We've meet a lot of interesting people with interesting ideas. We've had older couples, young couples, small ceremonies and large ones. Some of the things we've learned and changes we are making are; - an approved list of DJ's that we know will comply with the noise ordinance and a stiff penalty written into the contract for violations. We don't have a lot of control over clapping and cheering but we've found that a good DJ/MC can do a lot to keep people in check. We've done a lot of wrestling with DJ's and apologize for those that have insisted on pushing the envelope. We've banned the non complient DJ's and put those we know we can trust on our preferred list. I also bought a noise meter earlier in the season and routinely montor the noise levels from different areas around the property. - we are having a directional sign made that we plan to put at Carvers rd and Mt. Murphy during events that encourages people to drive slow. We open the gates early for guests and have instructed our parking attendants to move cars in off the road quickly to avoid back ups. - we discourage or disallow buses, super stretch limos and photos at the bridge to avoid congestion.

These are just some of the things we are working on and we appreciate your feed back and input you've provided. 2017 is booking up fast and we already have bookings in 2018. A lot of people in our community benefit from these events including many local caterers and their staff, florists, Dus, wedding planners, photographers, local hospitalities, cake and pastry chefs like Teal from Sierra Rising and lve even seen honey from Coloma gold. They have speakers all around the piazza for playing music from an MP3 player, and there's also a DJ and dance area just above the piazza, in the courtyard in front of the house.
