I am particularly interested in this opportunity because it will allow me to continue to follow my personal and professional passions of facilitating collaborative efforts to enhance and protect river systems. I would welcome the opportunity to serve in a public service setting to ensure the recreational, residential, and commercial value of the river is upheld.

I have recently moved back to the area after being away for college, and graduate school. Prior to college I spent a great deal of time kayaking on the South Fork of the American River (Chili Bar).
