
Western Placerville Interchange Project Phase 2


Project Overview

- The Western Placerville Interchange Phase 2 Project (Project) proposes to construct:
 - New eastbound HWY 50 off-ramp
 - Park and Ride facility
 - Connection of the El Dorado Trail between Placerville Dr. and Ray Lawyer Dr.
- The Project will also serve to improve Transit bus drop-off/pick-ups and provide for the future construction of a Phase 3 project.

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Right of Way Acquisition

- County owns APN 325-300-37
- City proposes to acquire from the County


7,572 SF of Fee Right of Way

33,417 SF of Slope Easement

10,306 SF of Temporary Construction Easement

• The City will maintain access to jail facility during construction, relocate the jail sign, conform the driveway and provide fencing as needed.

Conclusion and Recommendation

- DOT finds that the Project is a benefit to the County, therefore recommends the County donate the property to the City at no cost.
- Government Code section 25365 which governs the transfer of County owned property requires:
 - 1. Board of Supervisors to determine that the property being conveyed is not required for County use
 - 2. Public notice be published in the local newspaper
 - 3. A 4/5 vote to pass
