\$500K General Fund Allocation

The total costs for the overlays of Barbara Avenue, Martin Avenue and Black Bart Avenue is \$750,000. The remaining \$250,000 needed to complete the overlays will be funded from other sources.

How were the Categories Identified?


Subjective analysis of:

- Pavement condition index (PCI).
- Average daily traffic (ADT).
- Evaluation from staff in regards to the needs of the current infrastructure.

Our goal:

• Is to increase the PCI by an average of 3 points total over the three-year period. This will help increase the overall County PCI average toward the desired benchmark of 70.









Gold Hill Road from Cold Springs Road to Highway 49







Option A – Minor and Major Rehabilitation

Below are several of the anticipated roadways that need minor or major rehabilitation. The rehabilitation can include: pavement failure repairs, brushing, ditching, crack sealing, dura patching, culvert replacement, concrete curb and gutter repair, grinding of legends and placement of temporary road markers.

The funding will be allocated between labor, equipment, materials, hauling, and rental equipment costs to perform the needed rehabilitation for each roadway.










