

SINGLE CASE AGREEMENT

- It is agreed that this agreement shall be governed by, construed, and enforced in accordance with the D. laws of the State of California.
- Contractor certifies that it has not been listed by a Federal Agency as debarred, excluded or otherwise ineligible for participation in federally funded health care programs and shall notify Behavioral Health immediately in the event such exclusion takes place.
- To the extent permitted by law, Contractor retains professional and administrative responsibility for the services rendered.
