## NOTICE is Hereby given that the El Dorado

 County Air Quality Management District (AQMD) has scheduled a public hearing on September 12, 2017 at the El Dorado County Board of Supervisor's Hearing Room, 330 Fair Lane, Placerville, California, at 8AM or thereafter. AQMD is recommending the Air District Board of Directors adopt the proposed Sacramento Regional 2008 National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS) 8-hour Ozone Attainment and Reasonable Further Progress Plan (Plan).Ozone is created by a chemical reaction between yolatile organic compounds (VOCs) and oxides of nitrogen (NOx) in the presence of sunlight Breathing ione has both short and long term negative health fion , rang from effects, ranging from deceased lung capacity, chest pains, wheezing, lung disease, and potentially increased risk of cardiovascular problems. Western Dorado County is in "nonattainment" of the federal
8 -hour ozone NAAQS. As such, the Clean Air Act 8 -hour ozone NAAQS. As such, the Clean Air Act requires the development and implementation of a
plan to meet "reasonable further progress" goals and plan to meet "reasonable further progress" goals and demonstrate attainment of the 2008 federal ozone standard "as expeditiously as practicable.
The Plan geographically covers the Sacramento rederal Nonattainment Area (SFNA) which includes all of Sacramento and Yolo counties, and portions of Placer, El Dorado, Solano, and Sutter counties. Each SFNA air district will hold a separate public hearing to adopt this Plan.
