Most residents living in Cameron Park moved here for the rural feel. The lack of high density housing and grid lock on our roads appeals to us. Our Board of Supervisors and the developers are determined to take it all away from us. It's frustrating because most of the BOS campaigned for keeping us rural. We are not opposed to growth but we are opposed to the way this growth is being decided and to the volume of growth.

We live on the north side of Ziana Road and the tentative map of the Bell Wood Development indicates 10 homes being built <u>directly adjacent</u> to our backyards. One of the absolute joys of living here is the peace and quiet we have in our neighborhood. This will be taken way with probably 12-15 months, or longer, of construction and then with having neighbors directly behind our homes. The Bell Wood Development will forever take away a Quality of Life we enjoy here. Please consider an open space between all our existing homes and the new homes.
