Subject: Permanent Assignment and Overnight Retention (Take Home-Vehicles)

Board Policy D-4, Vehicle use, Standards, Procurement and Disposal, Section B.2., defines the requirements for assignment and overnight retention of County-owned vehicles. These assignments must be approved by the Board of Supervisors annually during the budget process. The Chief Administrative Officer reviews and maintains these records, and may initiate or rescind authorization on a temporary basis, pending Board approval. In order to authorize takehome vehicles, at least one of the following criteria must be met:

- a. An employee is responsible for responding to emergency situations related to public health or safety and protection of property on a 24-hour basis.
- b. It can be demonstrated to the Board that it is in the best interest of the county for an employee to be assigned permanent and overnight retention.

The Chief Administrative Office requires each department requesting authorization of vehicles for permanent assignment and overnight retention to submit a request with detailed justification for the request. It should be noted that the Chief Administrative Office does not have signed authorization forms for the Sherriff's assigned vehicles, as the Sheriff considers them to be assigned to his Department and therefore under his authority to be assigned.

Currently, a total of 81 vehicles are assigned to employees on a permanent, overnight basis. A total of 16 take-home vehicles are authorized to the District Attorney's Office, and 59 vehicles are authorized to the Sheriff/Coroner's Office. Along with the two authorized take-home vehicles for the Probation Department, the total for public safety related departments is 77, which represents 95% of all authorized County-owned take home vehicles. Of the remaining vehicles, 3 are authorized to the Transportation Division, specifically in the Maintenance and Operations Unit, and 1 is authorized for Agriculture. All of the current vehicles authorized for permanent assignment and overnight retention fall into category "a" and are public safety related. A chart detailing the current assignments is attached.

The Chief Administrative Office will continue to review take-home vehicle requests on an annual basis for continuation and rescind where appropriate. It is recommended that the Board approve the attached listing of permanent assignment and overnight retention of County-owned vehicles.
