Program Requirements

1) Provide a brief description of the proposed project(s) that you plan to implement with city/county payment program funds. Public Resources Code 14581 (a)(3)(B).

Project Description:

City County Payment Program (CCPP) funds will be used for the purchase of beverage container recycling bins at select gas stations throughout the County. Gas Stations will be selected based on highly populated areas and their staff's willingness to manage and recycle the collected beverage containers and report back to our Division.

CCPP funds will be used for the purchase of recycling/trash receptacles to be located in public areas throughout El Dorado County and its Cities. Recycling/trash receptacles will be located in areas frequented by the public (parks, city/town hubs, marinas, campgrounds, etc.) and/or on school campuses.

El Dorado County would like to start an Adopt-A-Roadway program for the roadside litter abatement on El Dorado County Roadways. If we adopt this program we plan to post "Adopt-A-Roadway" signs to promote the program and the businesses, no- profits, etc. that has adopted the roadway. If the program is adopted, we plan to use CCPP funds to have the signs made and installed along adopted roadways.

El Dorado County Community Development Agency Environmental Management Division (EMD) has collaborated with waste haulers and members of our community to develop an El Dorado County Recycling logo. This logo is being used to implement a County wide recycling education and outreach campaign. The logo is being placed on public recycling bins throughout the County and being added to education and outreach materials. CCPP funds will be used for printing of educational and outreach material (stickers and signs to be placed on recycling bins, window clings, etc.) to be distributed to businesses to help promote AB 341 Mandatory Commercial Recycling, etc..
