

## RESOLUTION NO. 179-2017

## OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF EL DORADO

WHEREAS, representatives of the County of El Dorado and representatives of the El Dorado County Criminal Attorneys' Association (EDCCAA) representing employees in the Criminal Attorney bargaining unit have met and negotiated in good faith since December 21, 2016, and,

WHEREAS, said representatives have reached an agreement on a variety of terms and conditions of employment for employees in the Criminal Attorney bargaining unit to be incorporated as the successor Memorandum of Understanding for the period covering January 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018, and,

WHEREAS, members of the EDCCAA representing the Criminal Attorney bargaining unit have held elections and voted to ratify the negotiated terms and conditions contained within the tentative agreement for the successor Memorandum of Understanding and,

WHEREAS, the previous Memorandum of Understanding between the County of El Dorado and the EDCCAA representing employees in the Criminal Attorney bargaining unit, expired December 31, 2016, and the County representatives are now bringing the negotiated and fully executed successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated herein to the Board of Supervisors for final approval,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado approve, adopt and authorize the Chair to sign this Resolution and the Successor Memorandum of Understanding that is attached and incorporated herein between the County of El Dorado and the EDCCAA representing employees in the Criminal Attorney bargaining unit, for the period January 1, 2017, through June 30, 2018.

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors for the County of El Dorado direct the Human Resources Department and the Payroll Division of the Auditor/Controller's Office to implement a \$1,500.00 lump sum payment no later than the third full pay period following Board of Supervisors' final approval of this Memorandum of Understanding for each regular employee who is a member of the Criminal Attorney bargaining unit who is employed on the date the Board of Supervisors signs this Memorandum of Understanding.
