

Community Corrections Partnership

As a member of the CCP, the El Dorado County Office of Education (EDCOE) provides educational services for the Sheriff and the Probation Department. Educational programs are delivered at both the Placerville and South Lake Tahoe Jails, as well as at the Probation Department's Community Corrections Center. Adult learners have the opportunity to access a variety of educational programs, including the following: high school transcript evaluation and diploma courses, a General Education Development (GED) certificate, Career Technical Education courses and certifications, career development opportunities, and college courses. EDCOE also operates El Dorado County's only Pearson Vue Testing Center, which provides the community with the ability to earn hundreds of industry-approved certifications, to pass the GED, and/or to receive tutoring support.
