WARABI CITY'S 50TH ANNIVERSARY

WHEREAS, El Dorado County congratulates Warabi City, Japan on their 50th anniversary of incorporation as a city; and

WHEREAS, Warabi City, Japan and El Dorado County California, U.S.A. have maintained a "Sister City" relationship for the past thirty-four (34) years; and

WHEREAS, During the past thirty-four (34) years El Dorado County and Warabi City have enhanced their mutual understanding and friendship through the Sister-City exchange and experience; and

WHEREAS, El Dorado County has a historical connection to Warabi City, Japan through the Japanese citizens who relocated to the Gold Hill area in El Dorado County to establish a tea and silk farm one mile from the gold discovery site in 1869; and

WHEREAS, The 1851 circa drawing of Sutter's Mill in Coloma, where gold was discovered, represents that connection with the Japanese citizens.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors extends their congratulations to our Sister City, Warabi City for 50 years incorporated as a city.
